

**I.2: Horticulture activities and Clean & Green initiatives**

**Landscaping:**

The landscaping work from CISF rotary to Sukhniwas Palace and around Lake Side Community Centre and the development of a rose garden with 500 rose grafts in the vicinity of Diamond Jubilee (DJ) Guest House was completed. Figures I.2.1, I.2.2 and I.2.3 provide glimpses of the completed work.

**Clean & Green initiatives:**

More than 1000 Metric Tonnes (MT) of garbage is generated annually in the colony area. To make the campus clean and green, pile of dumps are not allowed to be accumulated. The dry garbage collected from individual dwellings and public buildings is stacked inside the garbage pit located at three discrete locations in the colony area. Indore Municipal Corporation arranges to lift the entire garbage on day to day basis for further disposal. The final disposal is done in an area located nearly 25 km away from RRCAT premises. Figures I.2.4 and I.2.5 provide an illustration of the initiatives taken.
